

BUBBLE PAINTING

Our Educator has come up with some art activities for you to do at home with children of all ages using materials that you may have at home on hand. Our first activity is making beautiful pastel patterns by Bubble Painting.

Materials:

- Watercolour paint
- Water
- Sugar
- Dishwashing liquid
- Several small bowls
- Straws
- Paper

Mix water, sugar and dishwashing liquid together.

Divide bubble mixture into small bowls and add paints.

Tip: If using regular paints, you may need to add some more water and/or dishwashing liquid to get a runny consistency to blow bubbles.

Using the straws, blow into the paint mixture to create lots of bubbles so they rise above the bowls.

Place the paper lightly on top of the bubbles until they stop popping.

Carefully lift the paper off the bowls, trying not to smudge the paint. Leave your piece of paper to dry.

You can then use this to cut different shapes or just leave as a beautiful piece of artwork.
