## **EASTER BONNETS**

With Easter only a few weeks away, get into the Easter spirits by making an Easter Bonnet.

## Materials:

- A3 paper
- Staples
- Scrap paper and/or fabric
- Muffin cake cases (optional)
- Scissors
- Clear tape (optional)

Draw two vertical lines (approximately 10cm) as pictured in the first image (approximately 7cm in from each end of the paper).

On the opposite side of the paper fold the edge of the paper over (approximately 5cm) and punch a pair of holes at either end.

Cut along the pair of vertical lines. This should create three flaps.

Fold the two side flaps into the middle. Fold the middle flap over top of these two and staple all three in place.

Tip: Place a piece of clear tape over the staple on the inside to stop it from catching.

Using the scrap paper and/or fabric, you can decorate the edge of your bonnet. Thread a piece of material through the holes in the sides to create your ribbon. To keep the ribbon in place you can tie a knot, staple or clear tape it to the inside of the bonnet.
