




Te Whariki: Curriculum links

Communication – Mana Reo



The languages and symbols of their own and other cultures are promoted and protected.

Goals: Children experience an environment where: they experience the stories and symbols of their own and other cultures; they discover and develop different ways to be creative and expressive.

They will be given the opportunity to construct with Lego while being inspired by the work of others.

They will also be given the opportunity to work with woollen fibre. They will be given the opportunity to hear stories and to tell their own.

CAMP Children will be given the opportunity to view the Camp—Katherine Exhibition. They will be given the opportunity to build a campfire in the gallery space. They will be given the opportunity to gather around the campfire and sing campfire songs and hear some of the stories contained within the exhibition.

They will be given the opportunity to tell their own campfire stories.

BRICK FLICKS Children will be offered the opportunity to view the Brick flicks exhibition to be inspired by the images and to construct in the gallery place.

WORKROOM

Option 1. Children will also be given the opportunity to create, using glue, buttons and woollen blanket scraps and card. A cardboard tent shape will be included in the materials.

Option 2. Children will be given the opportunity to make Lego mini figure masks using yellow paper bags.

Option 3. Children will be given the opportunity to make tole Mini figures, dressing them as a favourite movie character. (suitable for 4 year olds)
