SHAVING FOAM MARBLING

Have a go at Shaving Foam Marbling. Our Educator used the rest of the shaving foam from Activity Three and thinned out the paints with water to make them last during isolation.

Materials:

- Thin card
- Shaving foam
- Cotton tips (or toothpicks/skewers)
- Watered down paints (or food colouring)
- A ruler
- A very shallow tray (pictured is a lid from a cake tin)

Spray the shaving foam onto a shallow tray.

Pour paints onto the surface of the shaving foam.

Swirl designs into the shaving foam using cotton tips.

Lay your card down on the shaving foam, and gently pat it so the underside of the card is covered.

Gently pull your card off and lay down with the shaving foam side facing up.

Scrape off excess shaving foam with a ruler and let it dry.
