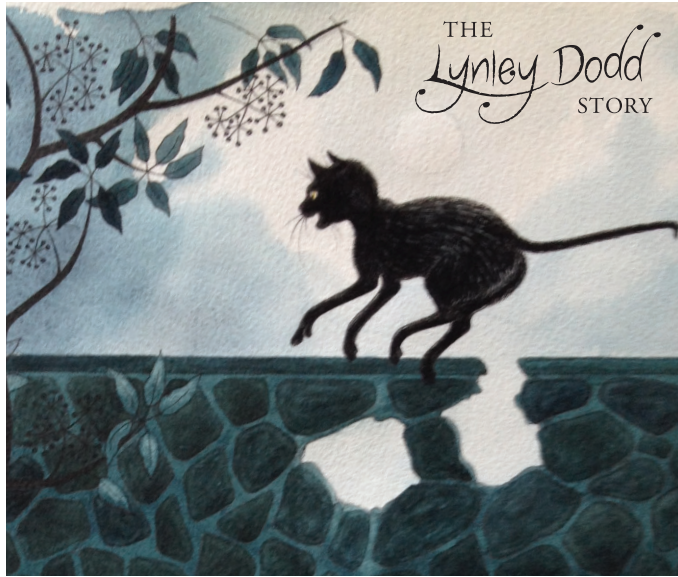


THE EVOLVING UNIVERSE

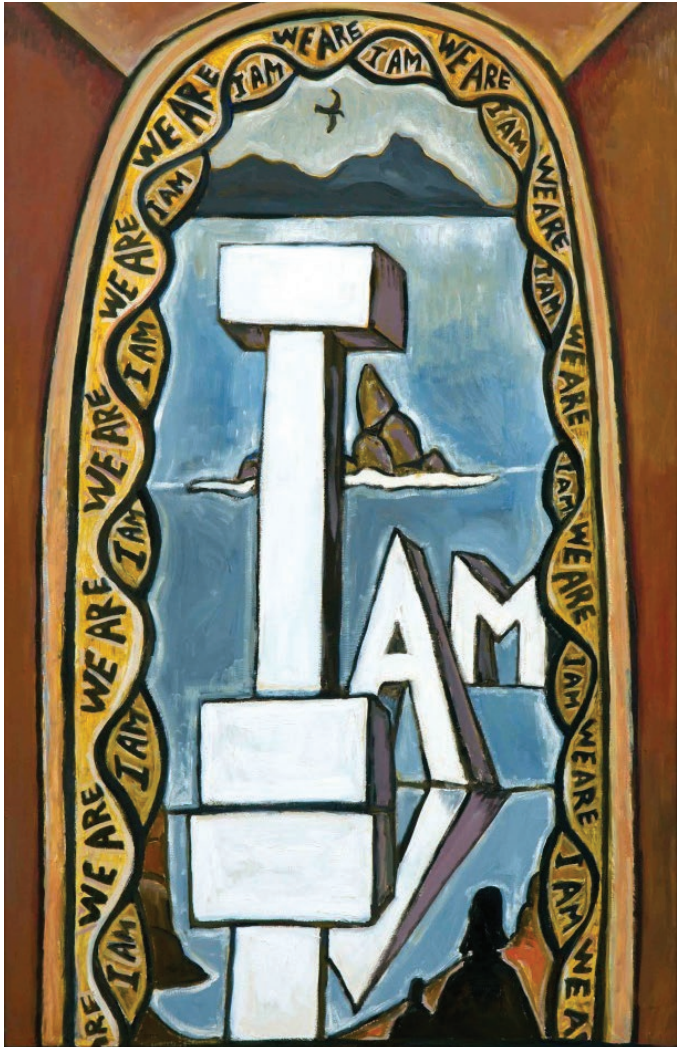

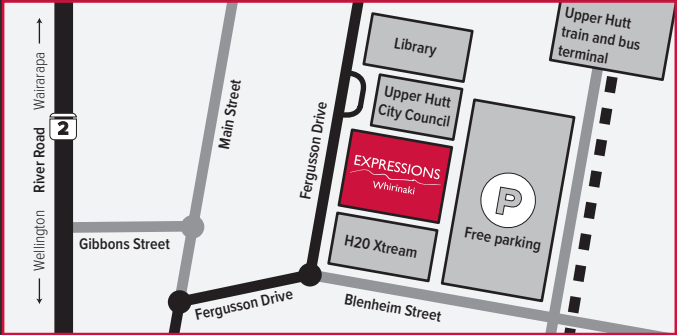
